INTRODUCTION OF SBV

Sri Balaji Educational and Charitable Trust (SBECT) was established in 1996 by determined and dedicated philanthropists with a noble cause of providing higher, technical and professional education as well as tertiary super specialty healthcare training and services to the students and stakeholders respectively of backward region of Pondicherry in particular and of India in general. It started Engineering, Medical, Dental and Nursing Colleges at Pillayarkuppam, & Karaikal of Pondicherry and Ammapettai at Tiruporur of Tamilnadu. The Trust initiated a proposal for the establishment of a Deemed to be University under Section 3 of UGC Act, 1956 encompassing its health science institutions and was accepted, approved and sanctioned by MHRD, Government of India, New Delhi.

Thus, Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth, a Deemed University came into existence in 2008 at Pillaiyarkuppam, Pondicherry encompassing its three Institutions as Constituent Colleges. The same year one more institution located at its of campus Ammapettai, Tiruporur, ChengalpatuDist. Of Tamil Nadu was also included under its ambit. Accordingly, today Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth popularly known as SBV(DU) has four constituent colleges and two academies and four innovative centres under its umbrella offering UG, PG, PG Diploma, Super Specialty and MD/MS/MDS/M.Sc.,/Ph.D., programmes under the faculties of Medicine, Dental Science and Nursing, besides programmes in thrust areas in the realms of Allied Health Sciences.

Mahatma Gandhi Medical College & Research Instituite is a multi-specialty teaching hospital recognised by the Medical Council of India for Undergraduate, Postgraduate, Super Specialty courses. National Accreditation Board for Hospital & Health Care Providers (NABH) has provided Entry level Pre accreditation to the teaching hospital of Mahatma Gandhi Medical College & Research Institute and ShriSathyaSai Medical College and Research Institute. The State – of – the – art, MedicalSimulation Centre of MGMCRI is recognised by American Heart Association as a training centre for various programmes. The cadaver lab (ASTRA) at ShriSathyaSai Medical College and Research Institute serves as an advanced centre for research.

In addition to these constituent colleges offering programmes approved by MCI/DCI/INC/PCI, SBV has started its own Centres and Academies.

SBV, as a Deemed to be University, took the initiative to establish two academies in the beginning

- (i) "SBV Academy for Health Professions Education and Academic Development" (SBV-AHEAD) and
- (ii) "SBV Academy of Integrative Medicine for Holistic Individual General-Health" Under these academies, four innovative Centres have been established. They are:
 - Centre for Yoga Therapy and Education Research (CYTER)
 - Centre for Music Therapy and Education Research (CMTER)
 - Central Interdisciplinary Research Facility (CIDRF)
 - Centre for Health Professions Education (CHPE)
 - Central Interdisciplinary Research Facility (CIDRF)

The activities of SBV- AHEAD & SBV- AIM – HIGH) are now integrated into the Faculty of Allied Health Sciences.

These innovative Academies and Centres of Education and Research as well as health care service offer unique programs – PG Diploma in Yoga Therapy (PGDYT), M.Phil (Yoga Therapy), PhD (Yoga Therapy) PG Diploma in Music Therapy (PGDMT), M.Sc (Medical Music Therapy), PhD Music Therapy, PG Diploma in Health Professions Education (PGDHPE), PhD (Medical Education) and PG Diploma in Pharmacogenomics & Personalised Medicine.





The Central Interdisciplinary Research Facility is a unique venture in a Deemed University leading to the creation of state of-the-art research facilities in the field of Molecular biology, Stem Cell Research, Phytochemistry, Biomarkers, Microbiology, Recombinant DNA Technology Immunodiagnostics, etc. SBV has recruited exclusive full time scientists of repute to the Centres to foster and implement evidence based research. SBV also has introduced Ph.Dprogrammes in selected subjects by approving research guides, facilitating enrolment etc.

Further, SBV through its institutions and centres offers a number of Value-added Degree, Diploma, Certificate and Fellowship Programs. These include B.Sc.- Medical Imaging Technology, B.Sc Optometry, B.Sc Cardiac Care Technology, B.ScAnaesthesiology Technology, B.Sc Operation Theatre Technology, B.Sc Medical Laboratory Technology, B.Sc Clinical Research, Bachelor of Physiotherapy (BPT), Bachelor of Medical Records Science (BMRSc), B.Sc Clinical Nutrition, B.Sc Blood Banking Technology, B.Sc Urology Technology, B.ScPhysicians Assistant and B.Sc Dialysis Technology.

The postgraduate programmes include M.Sc., (Medical) in Microbiology and Biochemistry, PG Diploma in Pharmacogenomics&Personalised Medicine, PG Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology in Clinical Chemistry, Clinical Nutrition and PG Diploma in Good Clinical Laboratory Practices, FUGRA (Fellowship in Ultrasound guided Regional Anaesthesia), is the first of its kind in India. In association with the American Heart Association (AHA), SBV is ofering Certificate Programs in Basic Life Support (BLS) and Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS). Thus, SBV over the last nine years has diversified its academic programs and enhanced its intake substantially.

SBV is constantly contributing to National and Global development, through Professional Health Science Education, Research and Tertiary Health Care. It has initiated quality steps and effective measures in all of its spheres to propel towards excellence. It has adopted the latest technology, innovative curricula, pedagogy, androgogy, heutogogy, Computer Assisted Learning (CAL), Self Directed Learning (SDL), outreach, and extension as well as examination reforms.

All of these processes have led to the creation and dissemination of knowledge, development of soft and hard skills, leading to global competencies for human and societal development. All oureforts have been made to provide excellent student support, facilities and care for growth and overall development.

SBV haslaiddue emphasis on the recruitment of qualified, competent and experienced faculty and a blend of senior midlevel and junior faculty. Good number of senior faculty from several premier National Institutions are at SBV grooming the young faculty into professionals.

Because of the academic programs available, excellent infrastructure, experienced faculty of merit and repute, feel at home. Student facilities, modern support services and green campus, students find it great to enroll at SBV.

Parents and students prefer SBV for its magnificent campus, academic ambience, discipline, safety and security and above all an excellent track record of performance and progression. Hence, student enrolment is on the rise. Girl students outnumber boys. Students from all over India are represented at SBV. It has a transparent admission policy and processes that are in pipeline as per regulations and schedules laid down by the statutory agencies.



SBV provides equal thrust and impetus to research, not only at its constituent colleges but also at the central level by creating CIDRF, Departmental Research Facilities, Excellent Learning and Clinical Resources. It has resulted in significant rise in publications and research projects. SBV is publishing four scientific peer-reviewed journals in addition to the Departmental/University Newsletters, Magazines and Chronicle. The striking feature is the involvement of UG students in ICMR STS projects, PGs in well structured dissertations and faculty in sponsored Collaborative and Interdisciplinary Research. The Management has promoted research at all levels through a significant and sizeable budget allocation for research and incentives for researchers. It has established firm nexus with premier national and international institutions for research collaborations. It has initiated MoUs with University Of Dundee-UK, University of Applied Sciences, KREMS, Austria, IOWA University, USA and Harvard School of Medicine –USA underPTA scheme.

Realising the need for Institute's Social Responsibility, SBV has undertaken meaningful and outcome oriented extension and outreach activities for the underserved rural people especially in the field of public-personal health and community development. In liaison with NGOs, GOs, SGOs, PRIs, SHGs - SBV has undertaken diagnostic, screening and therapeutic camps at villages, schools and privileged places. Tribal and Hilly area people are also being servedthrough the said programmes. MGMCRI is empanelled by Neyveli Lignite Corporation (NLC India Limited – Navratna – A Government of India Enterprise) for tertiary medical treatment for speciality and Super Speciality services for its employees and their families. The trust has also adopted a Matriculation school (Suddhananda Vidyalaya) at SSSMCRI campus to promote afordable education to the rural downtrodden and the underserved children.



SBV Main Campus (MGMCRI campus) at Pondicherry

Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth, Pondicherry is located in a spacious eco-friendly main campus spread over 48.097 Acres on the National Highway 45-A midway between Pondicherry and Cuddalore at Pillaiyarkuppam village, surrounded by several villages in its nearby vicinity. The main campus has easily accessible roads and transport, providing urban facility in a rural area (PURA), the dream of Bharat Ratna Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam. Its calm and natural habitat proximal to the beach of Bay of Bengal, natural fresh water lakes and sylvan-agri surroundings provide the much appreciated serene academic atmosphere devoid of pollution, trafic congestion and distraction. This true experience of academic ambience and home away from home for stake holders – students and patients.

This main campus houses the Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth's Administrative Office as well as four of its constituent Colleges(Medical, Dental, Nursing, Pharmacy) and five constituent centres (Yoga, Music, CIDRF, CHPE, CIDRF). It also houses the Medical College teaching hospital and Dental College Teaching Hospital (both of super speciality / tertiary level).

SBV Off Campus Centre (SSSMCRI)

The Off campus of Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth is located at Ammapettai, a real rural setup near Mahabalipuram, Tirupporur in ChangalpatuDistrict, around 50 Kms away from Chennai. It is spread over 148 Acres of land with aesthetically designed buildings and landscaping, in a valley surrounded by a hillock. It houses the second medical College of Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth – Sri SathyaSai Medical College and Research Institute (SSSMCRI), established in 2008 as well its Teaching Hospital (tertiary care) and ShriSathyaSai College of Nursing.

SBV has developed its two campuses on the lines of well-planned and designed eco-academic-green-clean campuses providing all of the required modern infrastructural facilities, sophisticated instrumentation, well-furnished laboratories and museums, ICT facilities as well as learning resources (print and e-learning).

The campuses have been developed as per the master plan, landscaping, with aesthetically designed building blocks, well laid roads and avenues, gardens, sports complex, hostel and residential complexes, in addition to the state-of-the-art tertiary hospitals with latest ICT facility at all levels.



The Medical college hospitals with OPD, IPD, good bed strength, modern modular OTs, ICUs, wards have imparted confidence among the rural population so as to utilize the hospital facility, professional consultancy, excellent nursing care. Provisions, radio diagnostics, endoscopies, 100 + Specialty Clinics, 11 Super Specialty Services attract a good number of patients from the nearby states to the portals of SBV for health care.

In brief, SBV aims at holistic professional development of students, excellent health service and care to the rural masses and would ever ensure robust public health, promote community development and contribute to the national development

To achieve this, SBV has the visionary benevolent management working with a missionary zeal and a sense of great purpose. It emphasises democratic decentralisation, participatory management, and good governance with transparency, accountability and responsibility all inherently depicted.

SBV follows all the regulations and directions of regulatory bodies in letter and spirit. As an ISR, it surrenders 25-50% of its intake (Courses not coming under NEET) to the State's central admission pool for the benefit of students of OBCs &marginalised sections of society. It has a robust audited review mechanism and well designed welfare measures and schemes.

With its commitment to quality, in all its systems, processes and practices, SBV since its inception has been aiming at quality assessment by NAAC to get the accreditation status by beginning the work in 2009- 10 itself. It constituted its IQAC in 2012 to ensure quality steps. It has set up QMS department towards its initiative for NABH accreditation. At present SBV is accredited by NAAC with A Grade with CGPA of 3.11 on the 4 point scale. National Accreditation Board for Hospital & Health Care Providers (NABH) has provided Entry level Pre accreditation to the teaching hospital of Mahatma Gandhi Medical College & Research Institute and ShriSathyaSai Medical College and Research Institute.

SBV obtained 72nd rank among all Universities in India at National Institutional Ranking Framework – NIRF - 2019. Further Mahatma Gandhi Medical College & Research Institute, one of its constituent colleges is ranked 23nd rank among all the medical colleges in India by NIRF – 2018.

Under the direct patronage of its Hon'bleChancellor, Shri. M.K. Rajagopalan, a visionary educationist and philanthropist, Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth is presently spearheaded by the eminent Vice-Chancellor Prof. Subhash Chandra Parija, Former Director of JIPMER and B.C.Roy Awardee to forge ahead in the realms of academic, patient care and research with conviction, fortitude and commitment


