






3. SBVU: PUBLICATIONS' TREE

FIGURE 2: OVERALL PUBLICATION TREND




4.2. PUBLICATIONS' CITATION TREND

FIGURE 4: PUBLICATION INDEXING ANALYSIS





FIGURE 5: PERCENTAGE OF INDEXED JOURNAL PUBLICATIONS






4.5.TOTAL JOURNAL PUBLICATIONS VS INDEXED JOURNAL PUBLICATIONS TREND

FIGURE 6: TOTAL JOURNAL PUBLICATIONS VS INDEXED JOURNAL PUBLICATIONS






4.6. JOURNAL DATABASE ANALYSIS

FIGURE 8: PUBLICATION LEVEL ANALYSIS



FIGURE 9: JOURNAL LEVEL ANALYSIS



FIGURE 10: INSTITUTIONS' WISE ANALYSIS



6.1. SCOPUS






6.2. WEB OF SCIENCE
